

Duval (DU) is ranked in the lower middle range of counties in Florida (Lower 25%-50%).




Health Factors

County Demographics

The health of a place results from past and present policies and practices. The land known as Duval County, along with the entirety of the U.S., has been home for many thousands of years to hundreds of Indigenous nations. Native Land Digital "strives to create and foster conversations about the history of colonialism, Indigenous ways of knowing, and settler-Indigenous relations."

Duval County, Florida is Metropolitan (intersecting an urban core area of 50,000 or more population) and is connected to the city of Jacksonville. In Duval County, 2.9% of the population lives in a low population density area (500 or fewer people per square mile and less than 2,500 people). Duval County contains neighborhoods which experienced intentional disinvestment through Federal HOLC Redlining between 1935 and 1940.
