St. Johns (SJ) is ranked among the healthiest counties in Florida (Highest 75%-100%).




## **Health Factors**

St. Johns County, Florida is Metropolitan (intersecting an urban core area of 50,000 or more population). In St. Johns County, 23.8% of the population lives in a low population density area (500 or fewer people per square mile and less than 2,500 people).
