3 STEPS

To start earning your Certificate in Applied Public Health & Medical Education Research

This 15-credit (5 courses) Graduate Certificate in Applied Public Health and Medical Education Research aims to improve the understanding and skills of medical education faculty allowing them to blend public health, research and teaching.

1. Make the commitment

The certificate consists of 5 classes and can be accomplished at your pace; ideally within 18 or 24 months

Courses: Only 2 are required, the rest are electives you choose based on your areas of interest in medical education research and scholarship


2. Plan

3. Apply and start!

Complete the application process, it's simple: UNF application, transcripts from medical school, and CV. We will walk you through the process! What could be easier?



Courses are based on individual needs addressing topics such as: formulating research questions and designing studies, measuring health and educational outcomes with reliability and validity, competency-based assessment, program evaluation and evaluation research, adult learning theory and training, curriculum development and evaluation, and qualitative and quantitative research methods. Medical faculty learn alongside MPH and Education graduate students to apply principles to the healthcare and medical education fields.
