RESIDENT/FELLOW TEACHING SEMINAR

The Office of Student Affairs and the Office of Educational Affairs jointly sponsor a seminar each year to improve resident/fellow teaching skills. In addition to the educational benefits, this seminar helps to meet important accreditation requirements for Graduate Medical Education.

The half-day seminar is targeted towards first year residents and fellows at the UF College of Medicine-Jacksonville. Residents/fellows will attend the seminar off-campus and must be released from all clinical duties to attend. Attendance at the seminar is required and must be included as part of usual work hours. These hours will be logged in New Innovations and may not lead to duty hours violations. The only circumstance under which a resident/fellow's attendance will be waived is if they are on vacation or other approved leave. Trainees that cannot attend the session due to leave are expected to participate the following year.
