

Baker (BA) is ranked in the lower middle range of counties in Florida (Lower 25%-50%).




## **Health Factors**

Baker County, Florida is Metropolitan (intersecting an urban core area of 50,000 or more population). In Baker County, 59.5% of the population lives in a low population density area (500 or fewer people per square mile and less than 2,500 people).
