RESIDENT MANUAL

EVALUATION OF RESIDENT, PROGRAM, AND FACULTY

The ACGME requires that all GME programs evaluate resident performance on a regular basis.

Required evaluations and frequency (frequency must be increased if necessary to meet individual program requirements):

- a. End of rotation – after each rotation or at least every three months (for block rotations longer than 3 months or longitudinal experiences)
- b. Semi-annual – at least twice per year
- c. Final – once at completion of program

On an annual basis at a minimum, but no more than quarterly, residents are expected to submit an anonymous evaluation of their teaching faculty and program. The Office of Educational Affairs also conducts an annual program survey of resident issues. These evaluations are performed using the online residency management software system, New Innovations (NI). Residents should contact the program coordinator for login assistance.
