

UFJPI Education: Chart Abstracting Workshop

This course is recommended for:

- Those who wish to learn and practice skills necessary for promotion into PBC positions
- The current CPC (Certified Professional Coder)
- Those who are preparing to take the CPC certification exam

This workshop will give the student a practical application of coding skills by coding:

- Dictated provider clinic notes
- Handwritten provider clinic notes
- Admissions and discharges
- Surgeries
- Diagnostic services (radiology/pathology)
- Diagnoses

This workshop will meet 5 times, which includes two 2-hour sessions per week. The workshop is designed as a PRACTICE of concepts necessary to apply coding knowledge in ‘real world’ situations. The focus is on coding experience rather than on teaching concepts. This is a workshop only; there are no tests or quizzes administered. CEUs (Continuing Education Units) will be awarded upon completion.
